
What is IFIP WG 6.6

- promote our area (like mailing list & RSS feeds for CfPs / Conferences)
- help PhD students (like tutorials on how to write papers)
- structure our research area (taxonomy, reviews)
- fight stronger against self-plagiarism and no-shows
- promote publications in journals (TNSM, ComMag, JNSM, IJNM)
- improve indexing of events (DBLP, SCI, ...)

- Existed before (2004-2006) as an IEEE Comsoc journal (eTNSM)
- Publication objectives
 - 2008: 4 issues (March, June, Sept., & Dec.)
- Online only
 - Included in IEEE Xplore and Comsoc DL
 - CD ROM with year's issues to subscribers
- Will start using Manuscript Central for paper processing






Osaka, Japan
