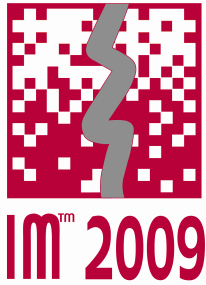

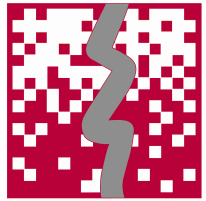

# APNOMS2009 Statistics

# Manweek 2009

---

- Location: Venice, Telecom Italia Future Centre
- Date: October 26-30, 2009
- Submission / acceptance statistics:
  - DSOM 2009 - submitted 50, accepted: 14 (28%)
  - MMNS 2009 - submitted 37, accepted: 13 (35%)
  - IPOM 2009 - submitted 35, accepted: 12 (34%), 5 short papers
  - MACE 2009 - submitted 13, accepted 6 (46%), 3 short papers, 1 invited paper
  - NGNM 2009 – submitted 5, accepted 6, 4 invited papers



# Manweek 2009

- 123 registrations
- Proceedings: LNCS, except NGNM (multicon)
  - MMNS: 28 needed / 50 ordered
  - DSOM: 48 needed / 70 ordered
  - IPOM: 38 needed / 50 ordered
  - MACE: 21 needed / 50 ordered
  - NGNM: 20 needed / 50 ordered
- Price of LNCS proceedings is OK, others not!

# Manweek 2009 Costs

- Registration costs:
  - PHD students: 395 Euro
  - Others: 50 Euro extra
  - IEEE member: 50 Euro reduction
  - After September 15: 50 Euro extra
  - Social event: 80 Euro extra
- Manweek 2009: Registration for entire event

# Manweek - Some observations as chair

- Many people are involved in organization
  - 11 TPC chairs, 2 general chairs, 6 other chairs, 2+6 local organization, 4 steering committee
  - More people is not always helpful
- Strong local organization is important
- Focus is on paper presentations
  - We need more interaction?
- How to differentiate between the various events
  - Different topics? Different acceptance rates? One Event?
- Title is confusing
