

Instructions for Belfast International Airport arrivals

Recommended route into Belfast.

There is an airport bus that will take you into Belfast Europa Bus Station. The “Airport Bus” stop is approximately 10 metres away on your right hand side when you leave the terminal building. The cost of the service is £5 one-way and £8 return. The Europa bus station is the last stop for this bus service. Once in the Europa bus station make your way through the Great North Mall and take a taxi to your hotel or residence, this will probably cost between £3 and £5. If there are no taxis outside the bus terminal you can call one on 028 9080 9080 or ask the hotel adjacent to the bus station if they would call one for you.

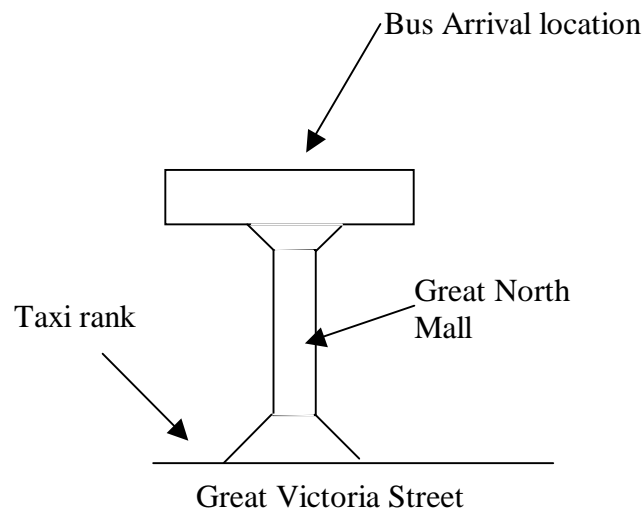
Alternative route into Belfast

There are taxis at the airport that will take you directly to your hotel or residence. This will cost about £25 to £30

From Europa Bus station

From the bus concourse you are directed through glass doors into the main building. Continue on in the same direction through the doors into the Great North Mall. Continue through the mall and out onto Great Victoria Street. There is a taxi rank to your right as you reach the road. There are also often taxis at the hotel to the left of the mall entrance

It is a 20 minute walk from the bus station to the conference venue and another 15 minute walk to the residences. To walk to the venue turn right onto Great Victoria Street. Continue in a straight line along Great Victoria Street and then University Road and you will arrive at the conference venue.
